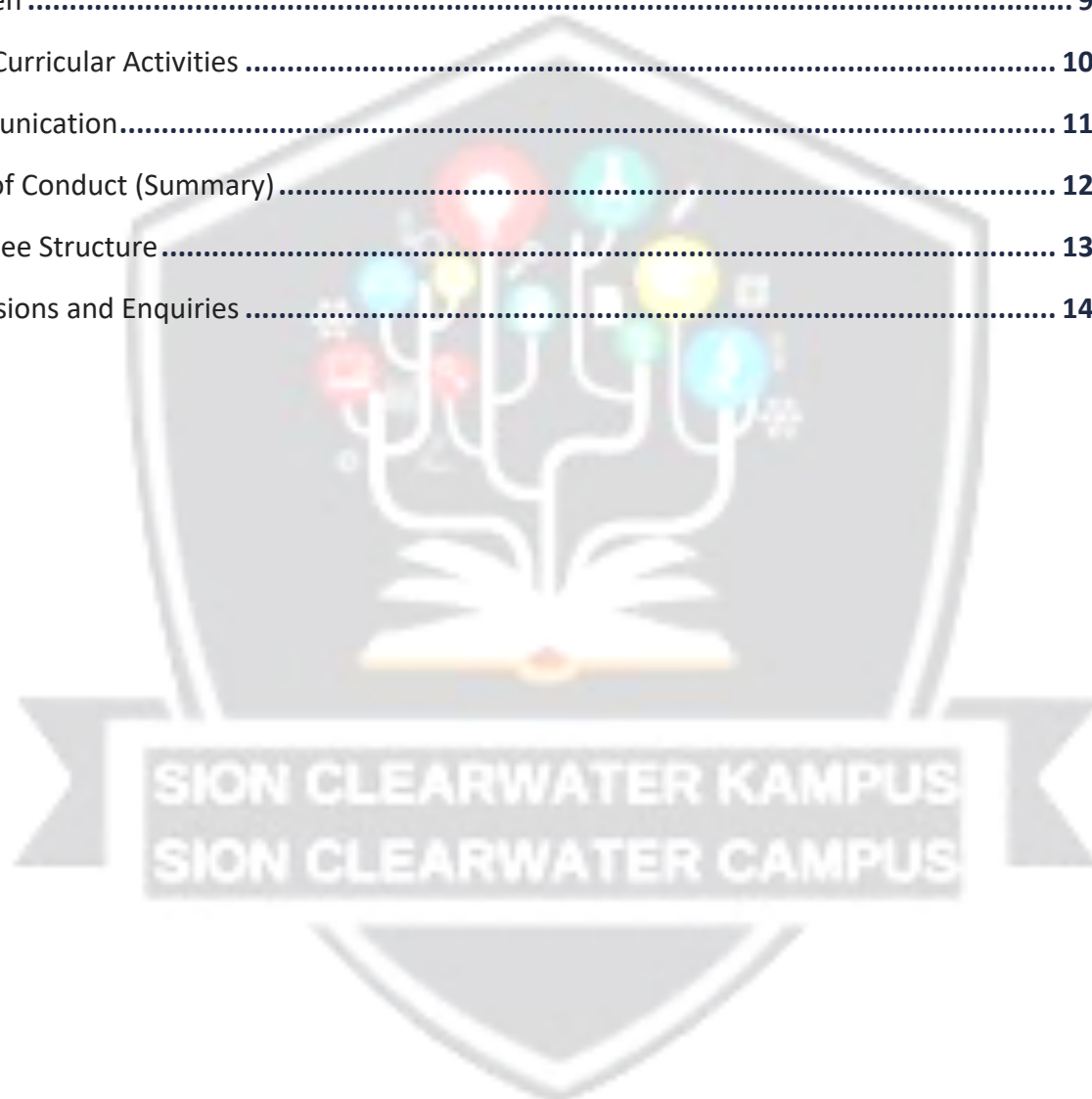

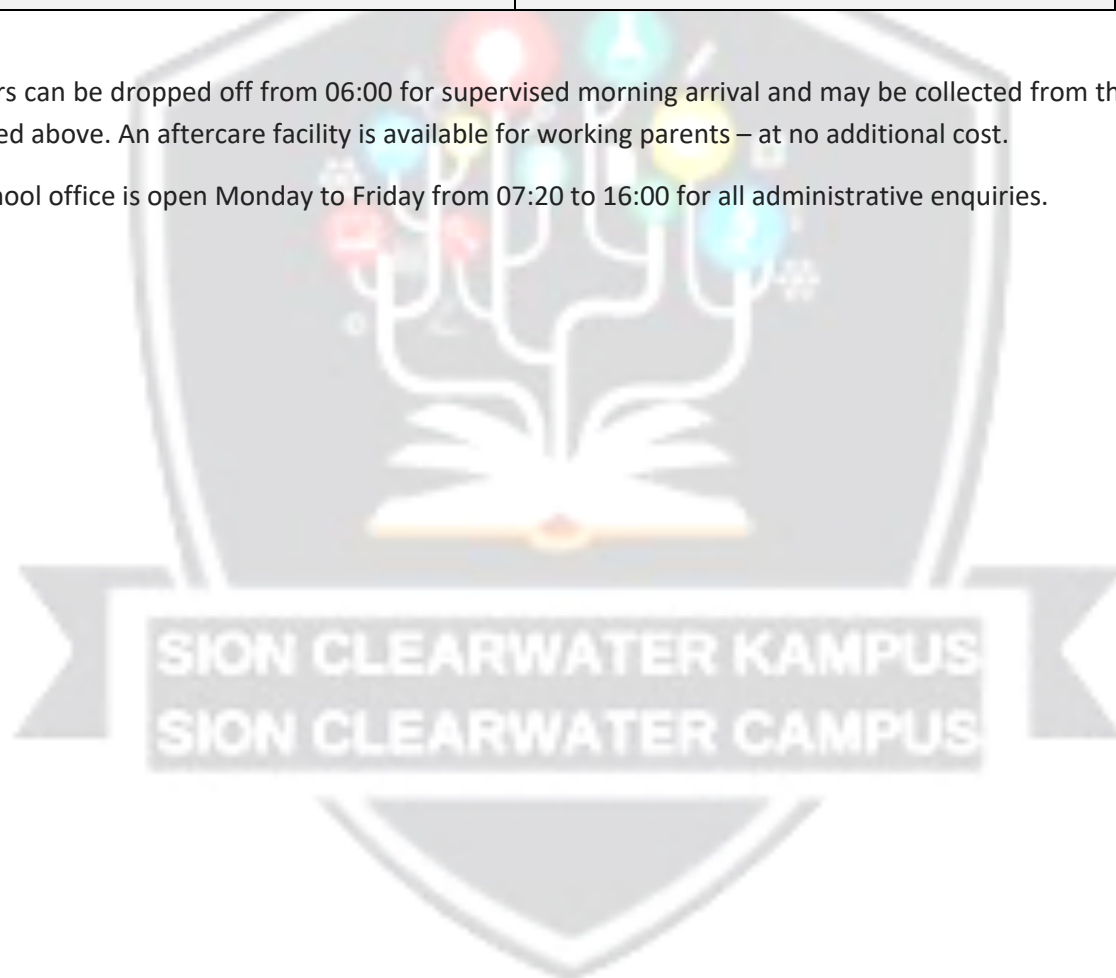
School Hours and Times

The school day is structured to provide sufficient teaching time while allowing for a healthy balance of breaks, extramural activities and after-care where required. Aftercare and extramural activities may extend beyond the times listed below.

Learners can be dropped off from 06:00 for supervised morning arrival and may be collected from the times indicated above. An aftercare facility is available for working parents – at no additional cost.

The school office is open Monday to Friday from 07:20 to 16:00 for all administrative enquiries.



School Uniform

Sion Private Academy takes pride in the neat and professional appearance of its learners. Correct school uniform, worn with pride, instils a sense of belonging, equality and discipline, and learners are expected to be in full, correct uniform at all times unless notified otherwise by the school.

Summer Uniform

General Uniform Requirements

- All uniform items must be clearly marked with the learner's name.
- Hair must be neat and conservatively styled; hair accessories must be in school colours.
- Jewellery is limited to a wrist watch and small stud earrings, in line with the school's Code of Conduct.
- Uniform items are available from the school's designated uniform supplier – details are provided at registration.

Learners who are not correctly dressed may be required to change or may receive a formal uniform notice. Repeated non-compliance is addressed in terms of the school's Code of Conduct.

Canteen

Sion Private Academy operates an on-site canteen that offers learners a variety of nutritious and affordable meals, snacks and refreshments throughout the school day. Our canteen menu is planned with growing minds and bodies in mind, balancing wholesome options with the treats learners enjoy.

- A daily menu of freshly prepared meals, sandwiches, snacks and beverages is available for purchase.
- Learners may either purchase from the canteen daily or bring a packed lunch from home.
- Special dietary requirements or allergies should be communicated to the school office in writing.
- A canteen price list is available in the canteen from the canteen manager.

Parents are welcome to load a prepaid canteen account for their child, removing the need for learners to carry cash to school – please enquire from the accounts office.

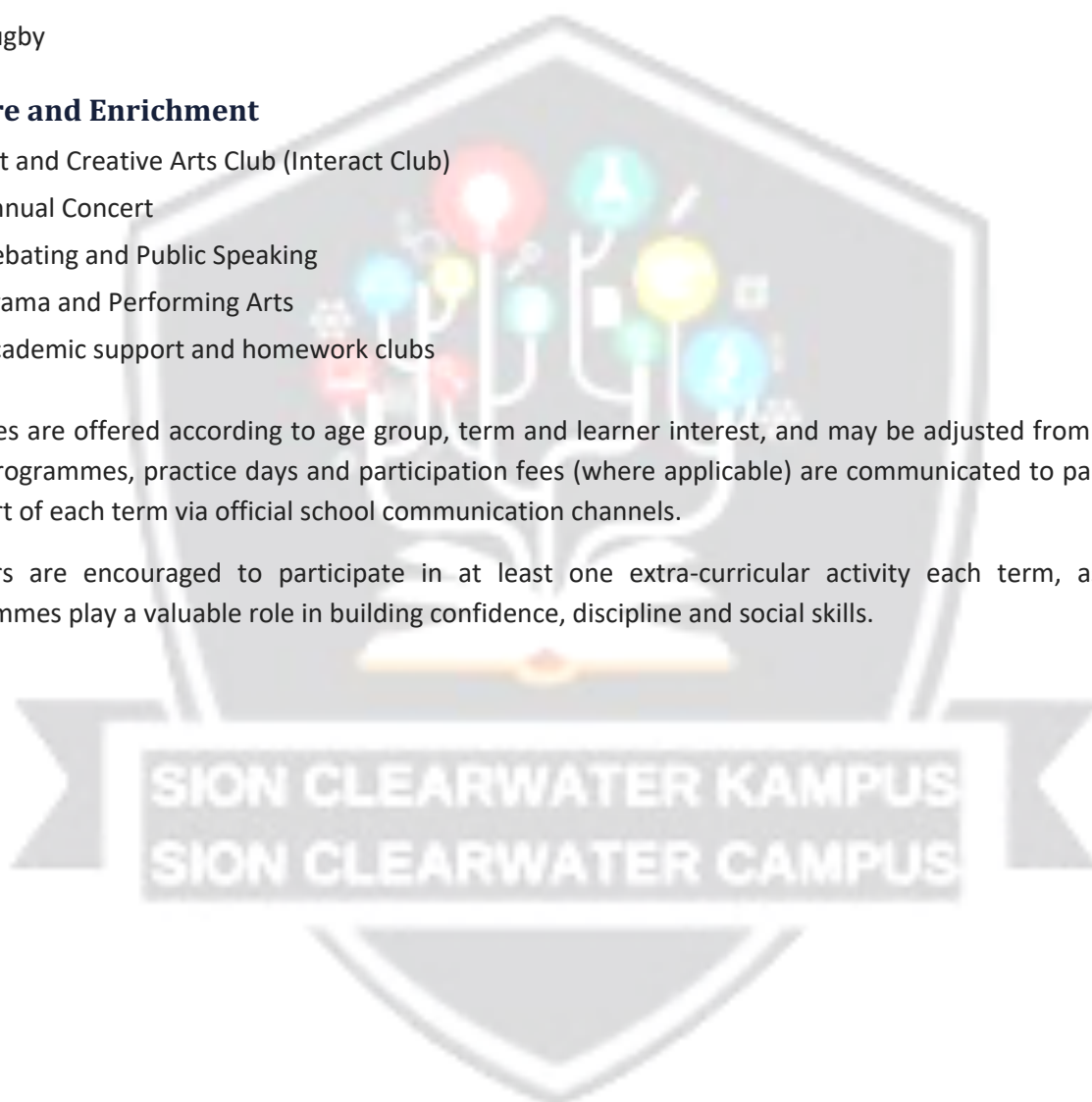

Code of Conduct (Summary)

Sion Private Academy maintains a Code of Conduct for Learners that sets out the standard of behaviour expected of every member of our school community. The Code is grounded in our core values of Respect, Integrity, Accountability and Passion, and aims to create a safe, orderly and positive environment in which every learner can learn and grow.

A full copy of the Code of Conduct is provided at registration and is available from the school office on request.

General Expectations

- Learners are expected to treat staff, fellow learners, visitors and school property with courtesy and respect at all times.
- Full, correct school uniform must be worn daily, and personal grooming must meet school standards.
- Punctuality and regular attendance are required, in line with the school's hours and attendance policy.
- Honesty, integrity and accountability are expected in all academic work, assessments and personal conduct.
- Bullying, harassment, violence, dishonesty and disrespect towards others will not be tolerated.
- The possession or use of prohibited items, including weapons, alcohol, tobacco and illegal substances, is strictly forbidden and will result in serious disciplinary action.
- Learners are expected to take care of school property, equipment and the environment.

Disciplinary Approach

Sion Private Academy follows a fair, restorative and consistent approach to discipline, giving learners the opportunity to understand the impact of their behaviour and to make amends where appropriate. Minor transgressions are generally addressed through guidance and corrective measures at classroom or phase level. Serious or repeated misconduct is dealt with through a formal disciplinary process, which may include parental involvement, in line with the school's registered policies and applicable legislation.

Parents are required to sign acknowledgement of the full Code of Conduct upon enrolment, confirming their support of the standards it upholds and their commitment to reinforcing these values at home.

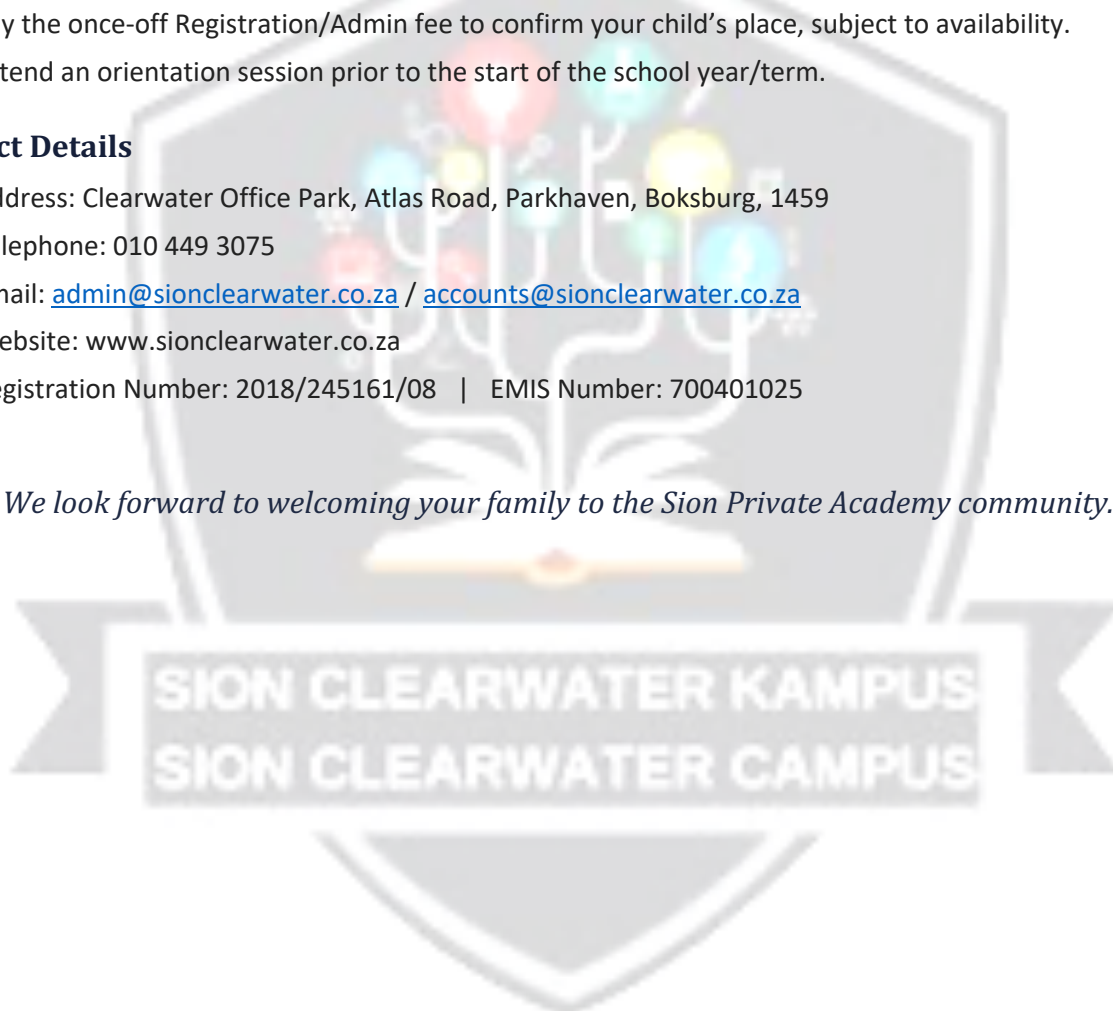
How to Apply
